Dear LMM Supporters and Friends,

Our Lutheran Faith tradition, and the instruction of God's word in Micah 6:8 lifted up by our founder, continues to frame our organizational values and vision that "everyone can thrive in a community of dignity and respect."

In 2024, with your support, we met our goal of amplifying LMM's impact! Through a dedicated staff of 150, and corps of nearly 1700 volunteers, we served more than 4,300 people across our four areas of service. A few highlights include:

- LMM was named lead agency by the Cuyahoga County Office of Homeless Services and launched a collaborative effort to address homelessness and housing insecurity faced by young people ages 16 – 24.
- With the support of the City of Cleveland Council, we received a grant of \$500,000 to research and pilot 3-D printed housing to bring this innovation to the region.
- Cuyahoga County provided LMM \$300,000 in seed money to support the launch of a new Building Maintenance and Repair vocational training program.

These opportunities align with the LMM Strategic Plan for 2024-2026, which was also launched in 2024. Additionally, a combined 800 people joined us across our multiple anniversary events throughout the year, including Founder's Day, the Charles R. See Forum on Reentry, and our marquee event, the 55th Anniversary Gala at moCA Cleveland.

The past year was truly one of abundance and established a strong foundation for us going into 2025. We entered the new year laser focused on continuing to make good progress on our strategic goals, also with the knowledge that we would need to closely watch the federal, state and local policy landscape in anticipation of changes that might impact our work and the people we serve.

We have and continue to adapt to this new environment, and remain financially strong. Our Christian values are the foundation of LMM, and we will vigorously lean into these values that call us to take care of the least among us. LMM's role as a safety net provider is steadfast, as we also invest in solutions to the many and complex issues that find many young people, families, adults and older adults in need of our services. Affordable housing as the solution to homelessness. Living wage job placements help people to get on a path to self-sufficiency and financial stability. Early intervention, life skills training and supports can change the trajectory for young adults experiencing homelessness. Decision makers for adults with severe mental illness or dementia who lack capacity, improve their quality of life.

Knowing that individuals, foundations, corporations, local public officials, and faith partners are among our supporters has helped us to maintain an abundance mindset. Each of you are a blessing to LMM and the community we serve.

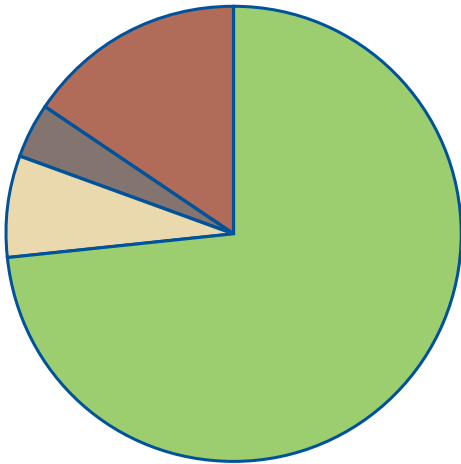

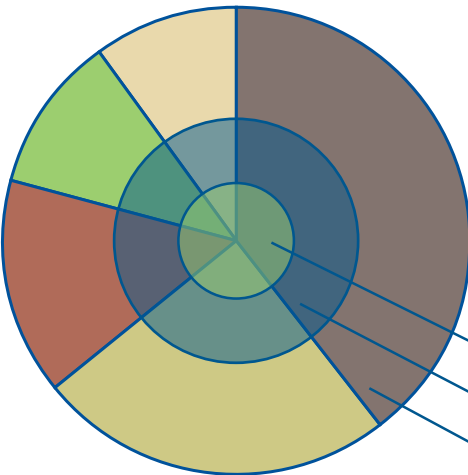

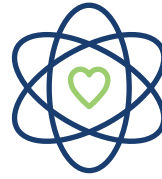

The Annual Charles See Forum on Reentry at The City Club of Cleveland addressed the **policy obstacles that inhibit justice-impacted individuals from obtaining housing.**

The Advocacy Department welcomed two new staff persons, including the Director of Advocacy and Community Engagement Coordinator.



LMM hosted both a Presidential and Vice-Presidential Debate Watch events, which featured expert panels on health and human services policies – two areas that the next administration would explicitly shape.

LMM hosted a conversation with Cuyahoga County officials and LMM Staff Partners on changes that could be made to the criminal legal system.

LMM organized transportation services to bring guests from our Men's Shelter to the Board of Elections to participate in the election process.



LMM worked with NEOCH to create a **“Voting While Homeless”** guide.

LMM hosted the Fair Chance Housing Townhall, which featured the stories of those with lived experience and the difficulties they experienced trying to get housing.

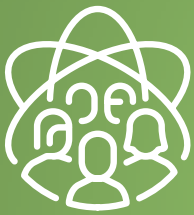

LMM continued to serve as a vital safety net by providing emergency shelter and developing innovative housing solutions in partnership with community providers.

The Flex Fund, LMM's Men's Shelter program at 2100 Lakeside, increased positive housing exits by 25% compared to 2023. This improvement meant that **131 more individuals transitioned from shelter into stable housing** from this location alone.

In total, the Flex Fund supported 322 people—including both single adults and families with children—by providing critical resources that led directly to successful housing outcomes.
